### 3.Chair's Report

Claire Ashton outlined the activities of the club, (presentation attached). The club was established in 1988, this year is the 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the club and we will plan celebration events.

#### Membership

Total membership is 296 with 63 juniors, 209 seniors, 6 beginners membership, and 18 over 65s, life and associate membership. It was noted that membership has reduced and fewer members are registered with England Athletics. This has reduced the number of London Marathon club places allocated to BRJ. Members are encouraged to register with EA, which has member benefits including reduced race fees, and benefits to the club.

Club renewals will be managed via Clubpal this year, and members will be sent emails with the link to Clubpal if they have not opted for automatic renewal.

## **Charity Report**

Gerry Pye thanked members for their support in fundraising for Cancer Research. A cheque for £2,325 has been presented to the charity. This exceeded the initial target of £2,000. Fundraising events included a very successful raffle at the Christmas party.

#### **Frostbite League**

Claire thanked Claire Few for her work with the Frostbite League, and organizing the BRJ race with Kate Ruddock and Alice Edwards. Thanks also to the club members who raced and volunteered to make the Frostbite a success. The seniors finished 8<sup>th</sup> overall and the juniors 7<sup>th</sup> overall.
